




Through our Impact Program, we help families with monthly expenses including bills & basic needs, rent/mortgage, utilities, and transportation. We also provide families with financial assistance for milestone celebrations, fertility assistance, and funeral assistance. Through our Laptops for Love program we provide patients a free laptop to stay connected with friends, family, and schoolwork.

2022 Family Assistance at a Glance

A look at the type of assistance requests we received for HFC Families in 2022.





The Breakdown of HFC Families we have supported:

- 57% of our HFC children are male; 43% female
- 72% of HFC patients are minorities
- 87% of the zip codes for HFC families have lower average incomes than the Texas average
- 84% of all families HFC serves have a household income of \$50,000 or less
- 51% of HFC patients have an income of less than \$25,000

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Impact Program

In March, 2-year-old, Ella was diagnosed with medulloblastoma. It was almost exactly one year after her older sister was finishing treatment for her own battle with the same type of cancer. The multiple diagnoses put a financial, physical, and emotional strain on their family. In addition to the 2.5 hour drive to the hospital, mom and dad were forced to split time between home and hospital with her four siblings, while Ella underwent a bone marrow transplant and multiple months-long hospital stays. We were proud to support their family with financial assistance during their childhood cancer journey with both daughters.



Laptops for Love Program

In October, 15-year-old, Ruzaani was diagnosed with high-grade osteosarcoma. He had been feeling a minor pain that started under his knee and a tender spot that would not go away. After a series of doctor's appointments, his family learned he had a tumor on his right tibia. Over the next few weeks, they discovered that his cancer had metastasized into his upper right lung and he started chemotherapy treatment right away. At the start of his treatment, his social worker reached out to request a Laptop for "a very active teenager" so that he could keep up with his school work and friends while he was in treatment.


